

LEARA Generator Raffle Rules

The raffle shall begin at a date to be determined in the first quarter of 2020. A maximum of 500 tickets will be sold.

Cost: Tickets shall be \$20 each. The purchaser must legibly print their name, address, telephone number and a valid email address on each ticket stub, or shall be completed by LEARA if purchased electronically.

Winner need not be present to win the prize.

Drawing: The drawing for a winner shall occur no later than the annual holiday membership meeting held in November of 2020, at a location to be determined, but may occur earlier if any of the following apply:

1. If all 500 tickets are sold the drawing will occur at the next regularly scheduled membership meeting, or a current meeting if the last ticket is sold at a meeting.
2. If 250 total tickets are sold prior to or during the LEARA Picnic meeting a majority of the Board of Trustees present may decide to hold the drawing at that meeting

Termination: A minimum of 55 tickets must be sold or the raffle shall be deemed null and void and an announcement shall be made to the organization's website, Facebook page, and LEARA news mailing list advising that tickets may be returned for a refund until December 31st, 2020. Unclaimed refunds after that date shall be non-refundable donations to LEARA. LEARA may also consider those non-refunded tickets towards payment of 2021 membership dues.

Prize: Winner shall receive a Honda EU2200i 2200-Watt 120-Volt Super Quiet Portable Inverter Generator valued at \$1,049.00 and purchased by LEARA from Amazon. If at the time of the drawing LEARA can not source the prize defined above without considerable increase in cost LEARA may, at its sole discretion, work with the winner to offset any additional costs, or may choose an alternate prize of equal or greater value. Winner shall be responsible for all taxes, shipping, and other delivery charges should LEARA be unable to utilize Amazon Prime shipping to deliver the prize.

Disqualification: If the winner becomes unreachable LEARA may post a notice on its website and Facebook page announcing the winner has sixty days from the date of the drawing to claim the prize, at which time the winner shall forfeit and LEARA may draw a second winner at its next Trustees meeting. If the winner refuses to be awarded the prize LEARA may immediately redraw for a winner at any time, choose to hold a second raffle, or choose not to award the prize.

Eligibility: The raffle is open to all legal residents of the United States. All members of LEARA including members of the Board of Trustees may participate in the raffle so long as the person drawing the winning ticket at the final drawing shall be an independent non-participant and shall not be permitted to win the prize.

The raffle shall be conducted under the rules and laws of the State of Ohio. LEARA is a 501(c)3 organization and no portion of the cost of tickets purchased are deductible contributions for income tax purposes.

Odds of winning vary depending upon the final total number of tickets sold.
