

Christmas lights are used for decoration in celebration of Christmas. The custom goes back to when Christmas trees were decorated with candles, which symbolized Christ being the light of the world. This custom was borrowed from pagan yule rituals that celebrate the return of the light of the sun as the days grow longer after solstice: the evergreen trees symbolising the renewal and continuance of life in dark times.

By the mid-20th century, it became customary to display strings of electric lights along streets and on buildings.

It didn't take long until skilled homeowners started to supplement the light displays with computer controlled animations, syncronised to music or sound effects.

FCC Ham Radio fees are going up to \$35, the FCC announced on December 29, 2020. It is expected that the new fees won't take effect for 60 to 90 days and that the FCC will give 30 days notice of the effective date. 1. Call to Order

N8OOF Bryan called the meeting to order promptly at 9:15 a.m.

2. November minutes

Jeff moved to approve November's minutes, Mary seconded. The motion carried.

3. Treasurer's Report

Jeff reported the current balance and reviewed the funds the raffle generated rough less PayPal processing fees that were not recoverable when buyers did not use the "to a friend" option. The generator was \$1050 and the winner was asked to pay the slightly increased cost and Ohio sales tax in accordance with the published raffle rules, which he agreed to do.

4. Member status

Mary provided a status report on membership. We are in the annual renewal period and will need to encourage members who have not yet renewed to do so between now and the March deadline.

5. Meetings

A discussion about meeting in person took place where it was discussed that other clubs are going to meet in person and provide a zoom camera feed for those who don't attend. No changes to prior decisions have been made for LEARA's meetings.

Eric reported that meeting programs are booked through February with a lead being worked for March.

6. Technical Report

There was a brief discussion about installation of MMDVM on the old 444.70 repeater. The equipment is with David Andrewjewski. Jeff mentioned that David plans to remove the EQ from the .76 site and hopefully make the audio sound better. At approximately 10:15 David Andrewjeski joined and provided additional technical committee update details.

7. Various

Discussion over the QCWA article concluded that we should run articles promoting anything ham radio.

Discussion about the club's membership database system in MS Access and his recent upgrade to Windows 10 took place. We have a functional system now, but some discussion took place about the effort that was needed to get it working properly.

Bryan proposed the idea of holding 50/50 raffles electronically for our membership meetings and discussion about how we could accomplish that took place.

8. Adjournment

Eric moved to adjourn, Jon seconded, the motion passed at 10:57am



FCC Reduces Proposed Amateur Radio Application Fee to \$35

The FCC has agreed with ARRL and other commenters that its proposed \$50 fee for certain amateur radio applications was "too high to account for the minimal staff involvement in these applications." In a Report and Order (R&O), released on December 29, the FCC scaled back to \$35 the fee for a new license application, a special temporary authority (STA) request, a rule waiver request, a license renewal application, and a vanity call sign application. All fees are per application. There will be no fee for administrative updates, such as a change of mailing or email address.

"After reviewing the record, including the extensive comments filed by amateur radio licensees and based on our revised analysis of the cost of processing mostly automated processes discussed in our methodology section, we adopt

a \$35 application fee, a lower application fee than the Commission proposed in the NPRM for personal licenses, in recognition of the fact that the application process is mostly automated," the FCC said in the R&O. "We adopt the proposal from the NPRM to assess no additional application fee for minor modifications or administrative updates, which also are highly automated."

The effective date of the fee schedule has not been established, but it will be announced at least 30 days in advance. The FCC has directed the Office of Managing Director, in consultation with relevant offices and bureaus, to draft a notice for publication in the Federal Register announcing when rule change(s) will become effective, "once the relevant databases, guides, and internal procedures have been updated."
