sidewalls of the pavilion have rollup metal doors which could be opened for an outdoor dining experience in good weather or closed in less pleasant weather. There is also a separate covered area with charcoal grills right next to the main pavilion. The pavilion also has full restrooms with regular indoor plumbing.

1. Call to Order

The president called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

2. Meeting Minutes

3. Treasurer's Report

Provided by Eddie Stevens, KD8FTS. Jeff is still working on transferring PayPal access to Eddie.

4. Membership Report:

Mary Grossman, W8AZO; 136 current.

5. Venue Chair's Report / Discussion:

Eddie, KD8FTS reports June was a picnic meeting held in the Kiwanis Independence Pavilion and well received. July will be at the Fire House Grille & Pub in Willoughby Hills. We will likely be back at My Friends in August and are planning on Teamz for the November Holiday meeting.

6. Upcoming Programs:

7. Net Report:

Commercial Interests Petition FCC for High Power Allocation on Shortwave Spectrum

The ad hoc group "Shortwave Modernization Coalition" petitioned the Communications Commission (FCC) to allow data communications on multiple bands within the HF 2 - 25 MHz range with up to 20 KW, including in bands immediately adjacent to spectrum allocated to the Amateur Radio Service. This group appears to represent high-speed stock trading interests. The FCC has assigned it RM-11953. Comments are due by July 31, 2023, and reply comments by August 15. While the petitioners exclude the amateur bands, high power operations on immediately adjacent bands are proposed. ARRL The National Association for Amateur Radio® is reviewing the petition.
